							Providing hand cleaning facilities at entrances and exits. This should be soap and water wherever possible or hand sanitiser if water is not available.			
							Keep Inside of vehicles clean, wipe down at the end of each day.			
							Stick to one driver, if the driver needs to change due to tiredness, illness etc. clean driving area when changing drivers (steering wheel, handbrake, gear lever, indicator stalks etc)			
							Carry anti-bacterial gel and / or wipes			
							Use disposable gloves at fuel pumps			
							Refrain from going into fuel stations in groups, pay with contactless if possible			
							If paying for parking, use apps or contactless where possible			
							Avoid using accesses in busy, built up areas.

							Provide suitable and sufficient rubbish bins for hand towels with regular removal and disposal.			
							Stay 2 metres away from other people.			
							Wash hands before and after using the facilities.			
							Enhance the cleaning regimes for toilet facilities particularly door handles, locks and the toilet flush.			
							The members should also be required to stay on site once they have entered it and not use local shops.			
							The members should be encouraged to bring pre- prepared meals and refillable drinking bottles from home to avoid frequenting places where there is a risk of cross-contamination such as fast food takeaways, cafes etc.
